## Enroll in FCEA, CTA, and NEA with one easy application:

- Visit <u>Join-CTA</u> and click on the dark blue button on the left "<u>Certificated TK-12</u> <u>Educators</u>"
- Follow the prompts to complete your application, or click <u>HERE</u> for additional directions.
- You should receive an email the day after you complete your application confirming your submission. This email will include a digital, temporary CTA card. Check spam just in case.
- Keep and print the digital copy/email as protection against error.

- An affiliate of CTA and NEA, FCEA is the exclusive bargaining representative for certificated staff, representing over 1,000 teachers, counselors, nurses, psychologists, Speech and Language Pathologists, and more. FCEA represents all individuals with contractual and work related issues.
- FCEA Voting Process: FCEA has online voting approved by CTA. This allows members to vote from any device, not just the school site. This process is used for surveys, officer elections, as well as ratification of Tentative Agreements (contracts). Once you become a paying member, you are allowed to vote in elections.

- Protect Your Paycheck
  - Educators are not covered by state disability plan
  - Disability insurance pays you if you're out of work due to an injury, illness (including mental health disorders and substance abuse), pregnancy or childbirth
- Enroll with no health questions asked
  - New educators have 270 days to enroll without answering medical questions
  - Educators from another district have 270 days to enroll without answering medical questions
  - Current members may apply at any time but will be subject to answering medical questions (outside of a Standard Disability/Life Insurance open enrollment event)
  - Retiree benefits available requires lifetime NEA/CTA membership to qualify
  - CTA-endorsed Disability insurance
  - Up to \$400,000 of CTA-endorsed Life insurance (for new hires) with no medical questions
  - Life Insurance coverage options for your Spouse/Domestic Partner and/or children
