

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING #6
between the
FOLSOM CORDOVA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
and the
FOLSOM CORDOVA EDUCATION ASSOCIATION

Minimum Days at Comprehensive Secondary Schools
March 13, 2024

The Folsom Cordova Unified School District (“District”) and Folsom Cordova Education Association (“Association”) enter this Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) regarding the minimum days at the comprehensive secondary schools.

Current contract language is as follows:

8.16 240-Minute Minimum Days


8.16.1 The elementary student school day (grades K-5) is increased to allow ten (10) 240-minute days. The middle school student school day (grades 6-8) and the high school student day (grades 9-12) are increased to allow seven (7) 240-minute minimum days. The middle and high schools may have one additional minimum day (total of eight [8]) if the annual instructional minutes are maintained and if the additional day is used for an Open House. These minimum days are to be used for, but are not limited to: Back-to-school night preparation; open house preparations; parent teacher conferences; and final exams.

For the year 2024 - 2025, all comprehensive secondary sites will mirror the minimum days scheduled for 2023 - 2024. FCUSD and FCEA agree to meet and negotiate the above contract language to reflect current practices and ensure feasibility at all sites. Elementary minimum days will remain unchanged.

This MOU shall remain in full force and effect through June 30, 2025.
