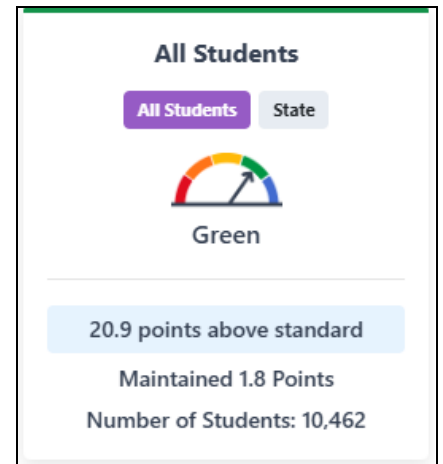

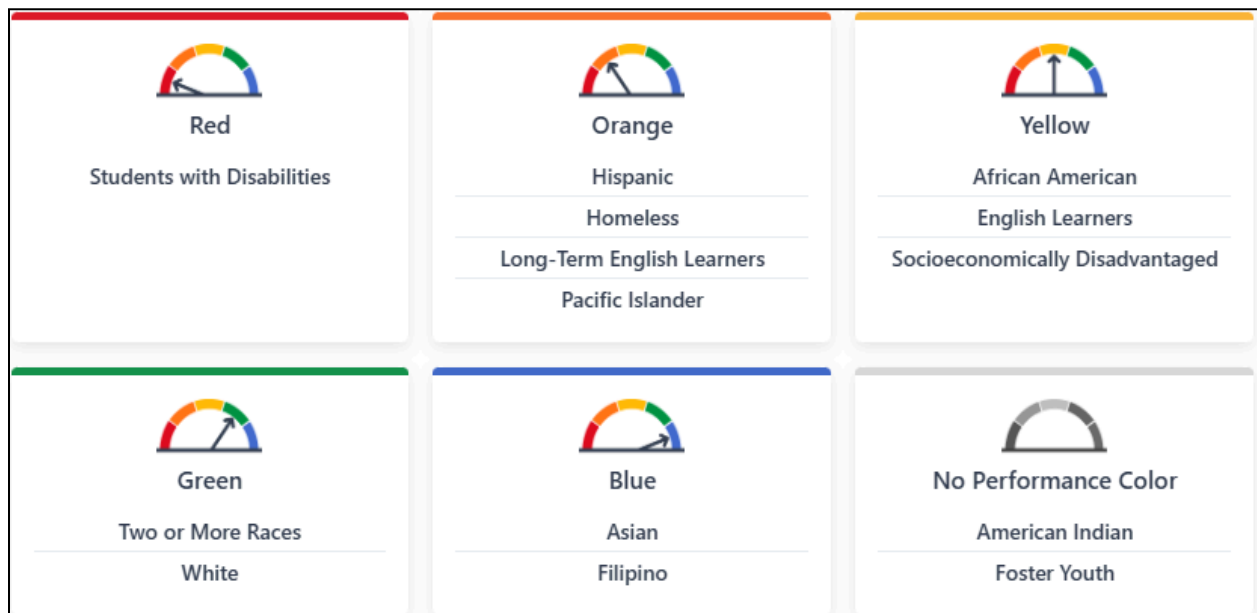
Data Set: This Academic indicator reports student progress on the statewide assessment for **English Language Arts/Literacy**. It uses the **Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and California Alternate Assessments**, and it is calculated based on the average **Distance from Standard** for all students in grades 3 through 8 and/or grade 11.

Distance from Standard measures how many points above or below (or the distance) each student is from the lowest possible scale score within the Level 3 (i.e., Standard Met) on the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and the California Alternate Assessments.

All the “distances” are used to calculate the average distance for each local educational agency, school, or student group.



Student Groups by Performance Level

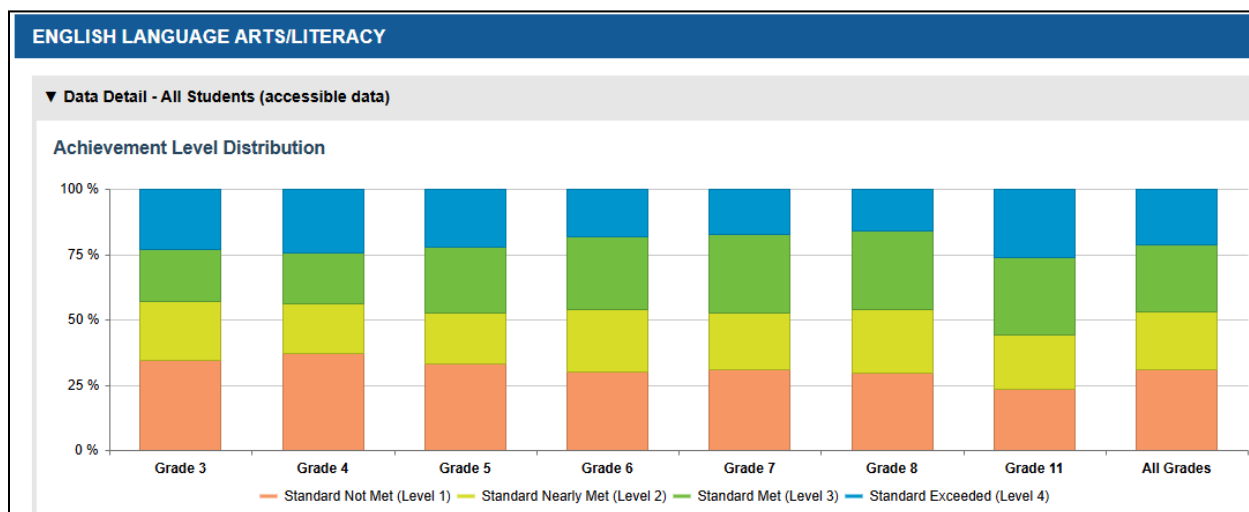

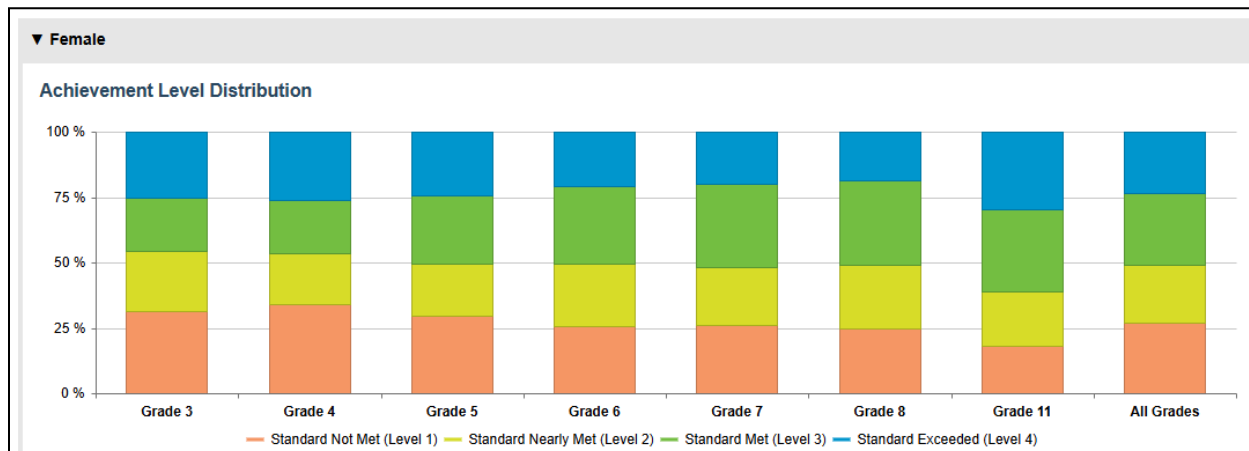

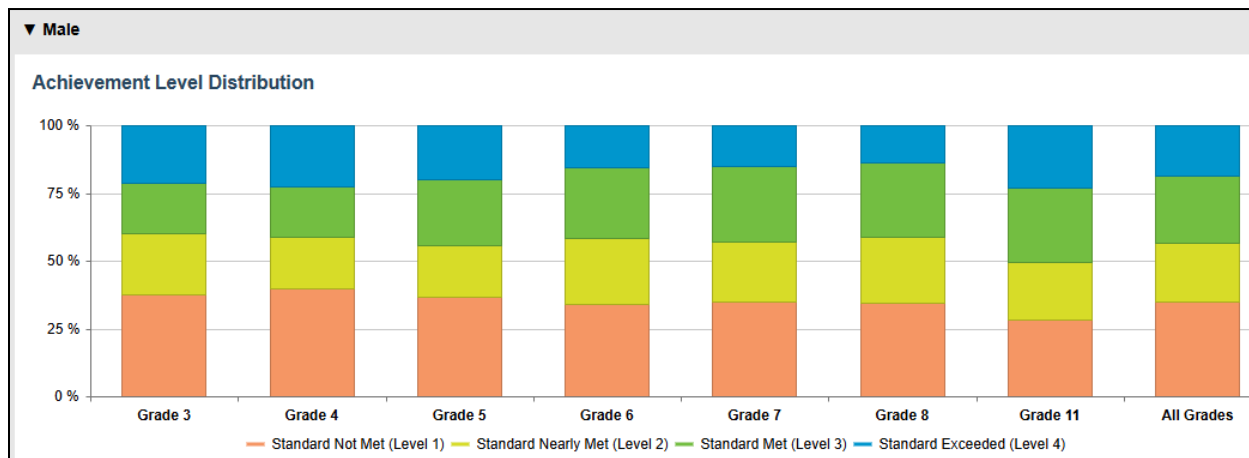

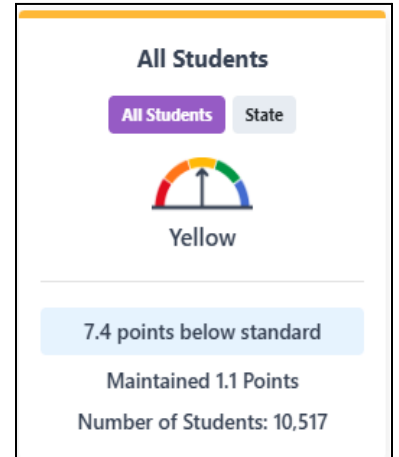

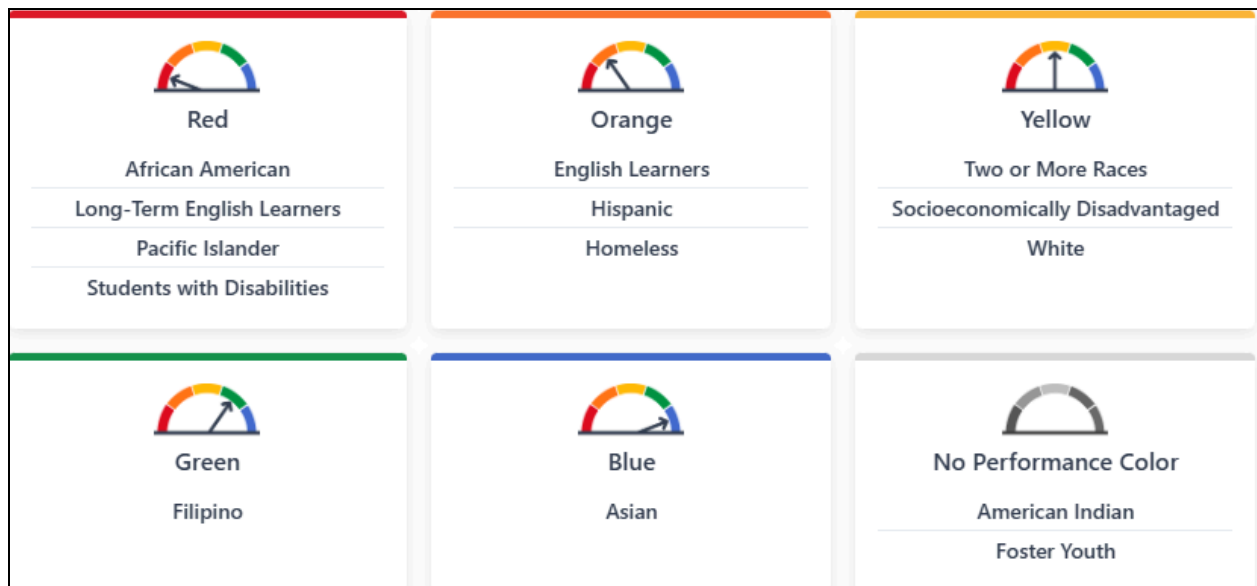
Data Set: This Academic indicator reports student progress on the statewide assessment for **Mathematics**. It uses the **Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and California Alternate Assessments**, and it is calculated based on the average **Distance from Standard** for all students in grades 3 through 8 and/or grade 11.

Distance from Standard measures how many points above or below (or the distance) each student is from the lowest possible scale score within the Level 3 (i.e., Standard Met) on the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and the California Alternate Assessments.

All the “distances” are used to calculate the average distance for each local educational agency, school, or student group.



Student Groups by Performance Level

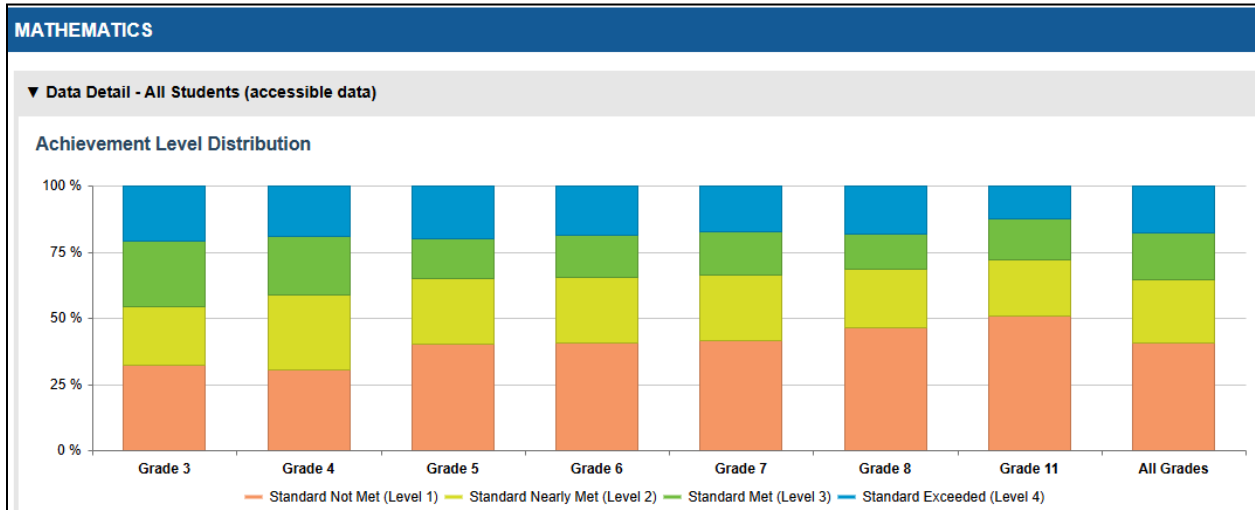

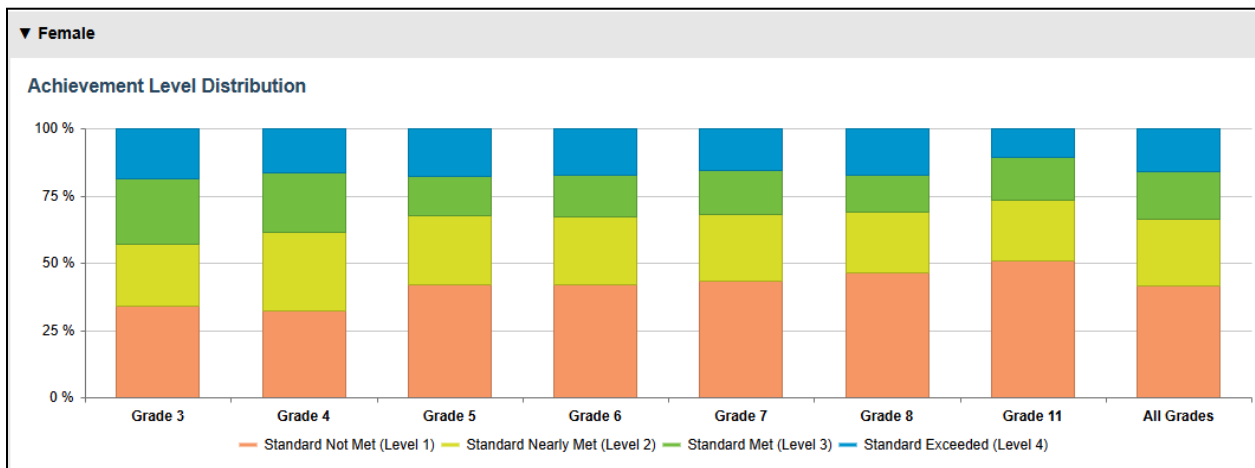

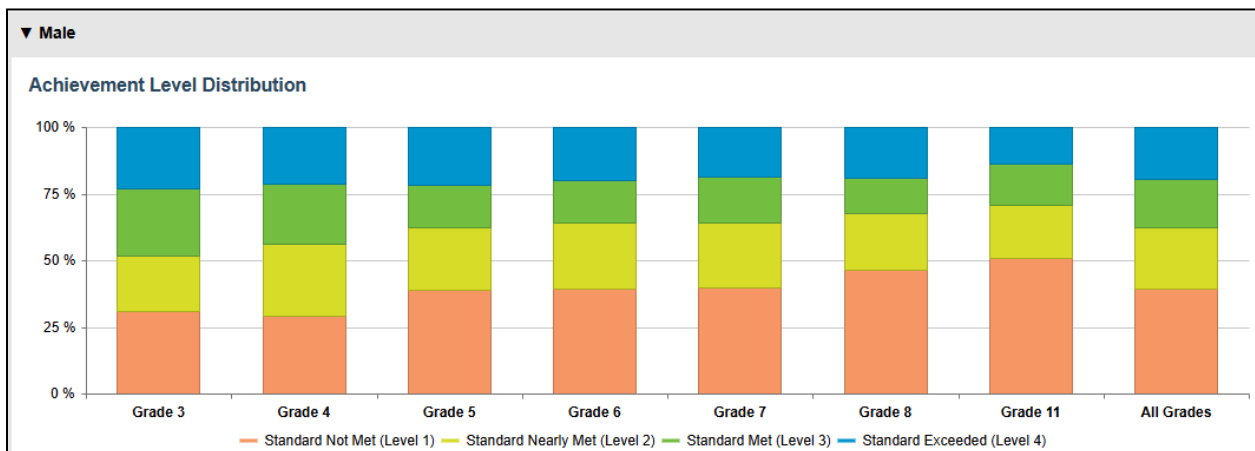

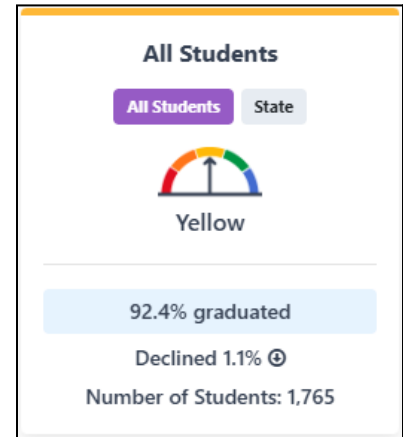

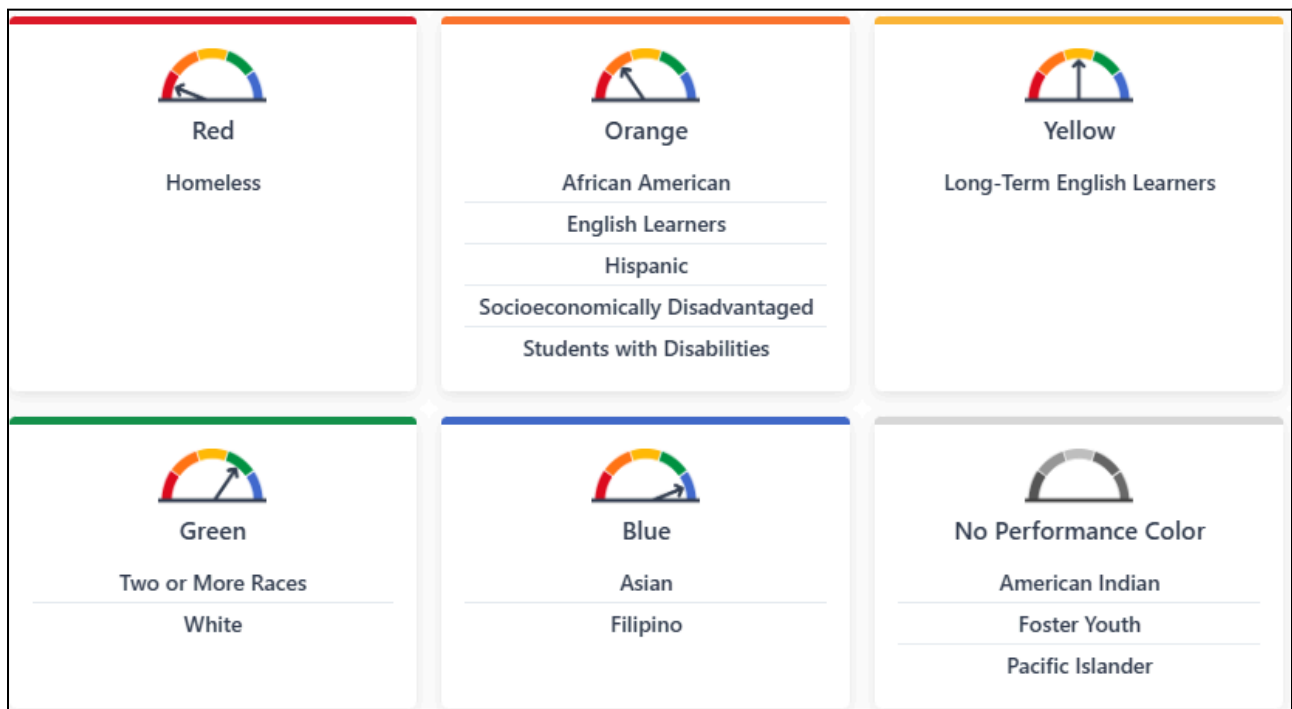

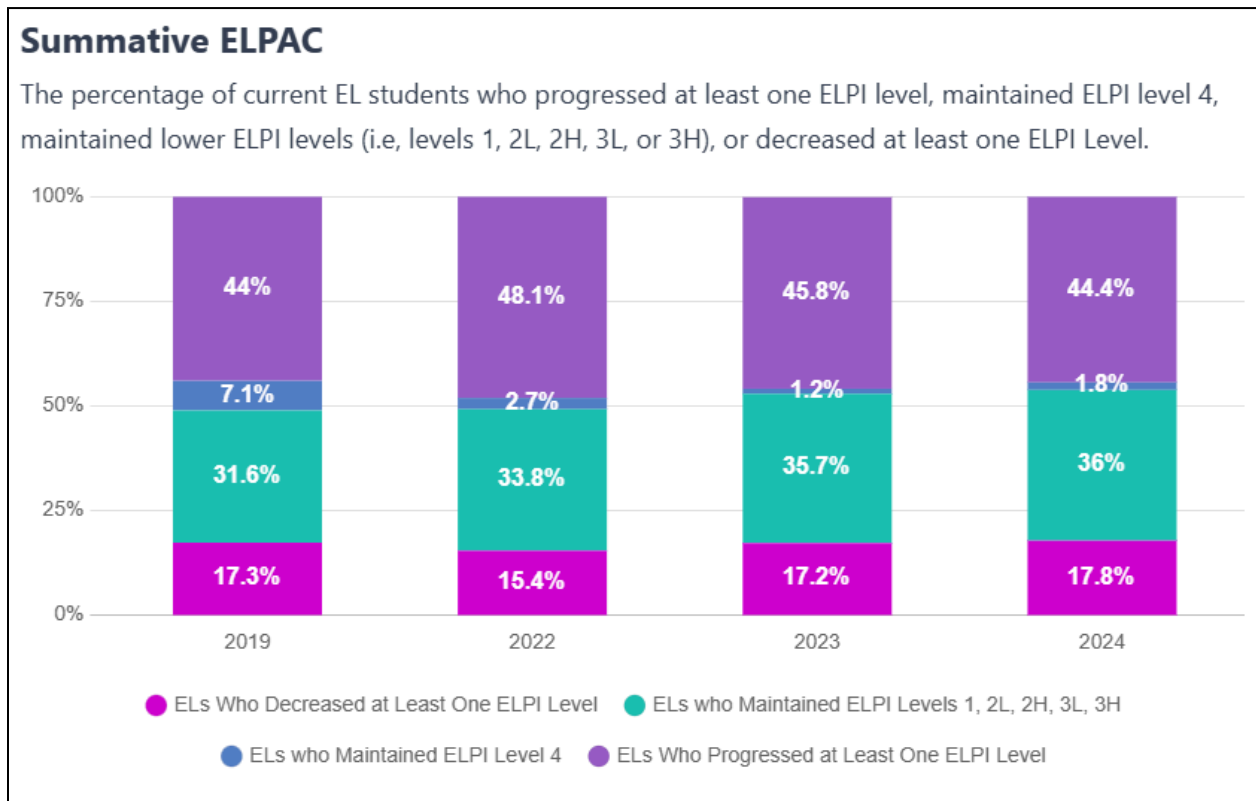

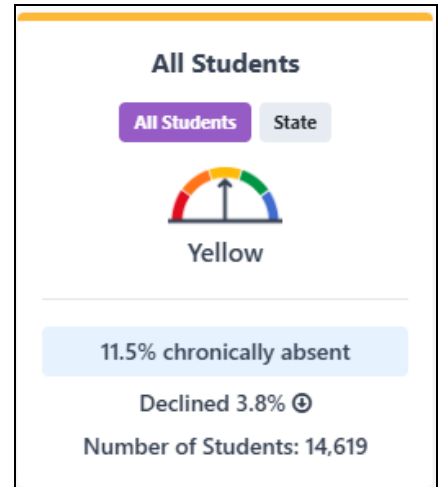

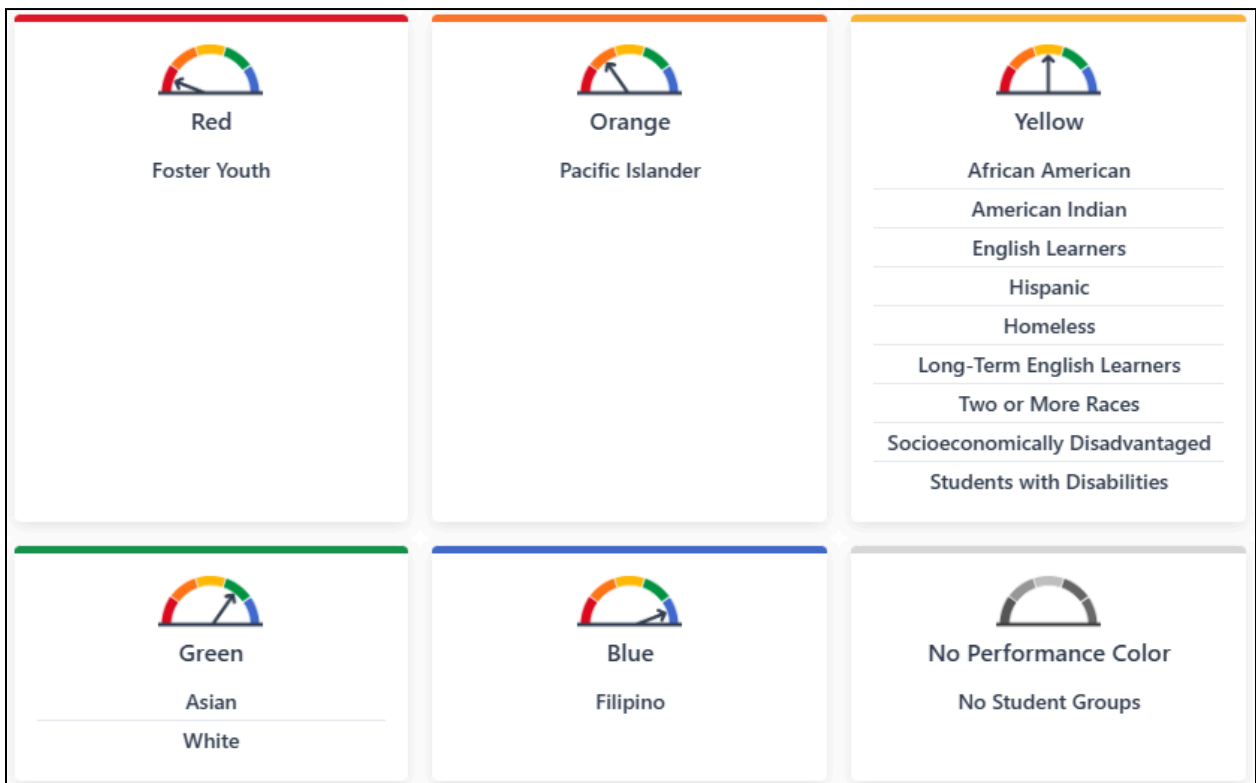

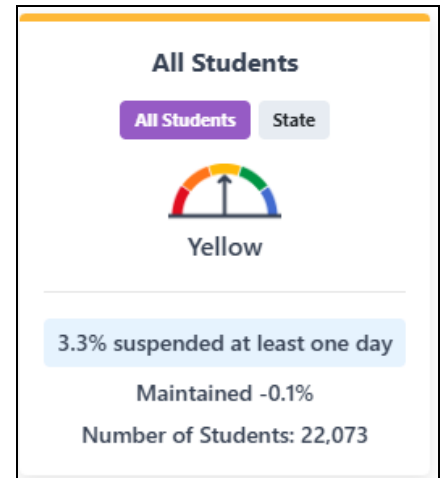

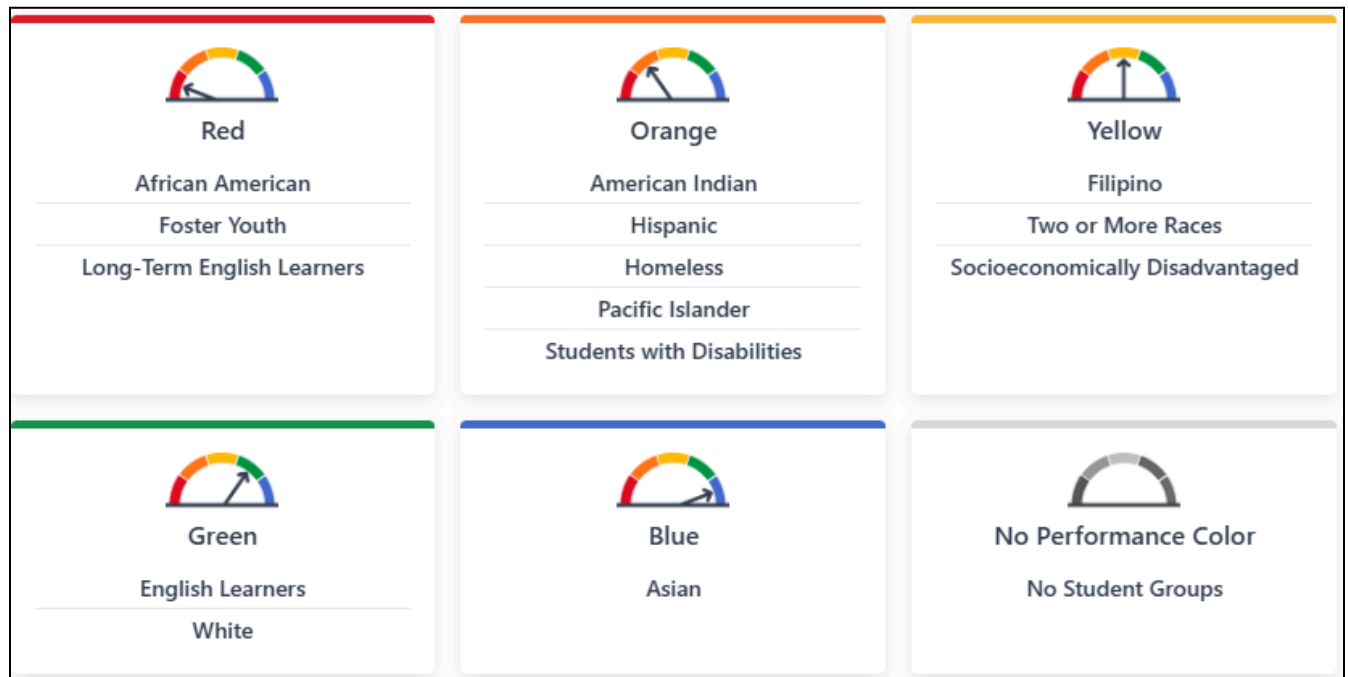
